



INFORMATION ABOUT THE OPIOID EPIDEMIC

Opioids (also called narcotics) are a class of drugs that relieve pain and include

- prescription pain relievers, such as oxycodone and morphine
- fentanyl, a prescription pain reliever increasingly made and distributed illegally
- heroin, an illegal opioid

In the US in **2016**

- More than **11** million people abused prescription opioids
- **116** people died every day from opioid-related drug overdose (**13.3** deaths per **100,000**)

In Georgia from **2015-2016**

- **918** people died from opioid-related overdose (**8.8** deaths per **100,000**)
- Georgia providers wrote **77.1** opioid prescriptions per **100** persons
